You are hereby notified that pursuant to JQCR 13, the Judicial Qualifications Commission of the State of Washington has amended the Formal Complaint on file herein by the addition of Count 13 as follows:

13. On June 6, 1984, Martin Hegewald, the defendant in Skamania County District Court, Cause No. 3114592, State of Washington vs. Martin Hegewald, filed an affidavit of prejudice against Judge Day. Judge Churchill was assigned to hear the case as a pro tem judge. Judge Day called Judge Churchill at home and talked to him about the Hegewald case, stating that he did not want Mr. Hegewald to "get off" and that he would leave a note on his desk concerning Mr. Hegewald and other cases. A note was left by Judge Day for Judge Churchill stating "Wegewald was convicted of DWI less than three years ago."
