STIPULATION PURSUANT TO WAC 292-12-020(6) AND ORDER OF ADMONISHMENT

Pursuant to WAC 292-12-020(6), the Commission on Judicial Conduct ("Commission") and E. T. Leverette ("Respondent"), Judge of the King County District Court, Federal Way Division, do hereby stipulate and agree as provided herein:
