Pursuant to WAC 292-12-020(6), the Commission on Judicial Conduct ("Commission") and E. T. Leverette ("Respondent"), Judge of the King County District Court, Federal Way Division, do hereby stipulate and agree as provided herein:

STIPULATION

The Commission has determined from Respondent's admission that he has smoked in his chambers contrary to King County Ordinance No. 7884, effective July 1, 1987, which prohibits smoking in county owned or leased buildings. The Commission has further determined such conduct to be in violation of Canons 1 and 2(A) of the Code of Judicial Conduct.


