I. STIPULATION

Pursuant to Article IV § 31 of the Washington Constitution, RCW 2.64, et seq., WAC 292-08, et seq., and WAC 292-12, et seq., the Washington Commission on Judicial Conduct ("Commission") and the Honorable Rosemary Bordlemay hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The Commission believes that Judge Bordlemay, respondent herein, suffers from a health problem which renders her unable to continue her service in the judiciary and, by her conduct, has violated the Code of Judicial Conduct.
2. Judge Bordlemay does not admit the truth of the statements in paragraph 1 above. Judge Bordlemay does not dispute, however, that the Commission, based upon its determinations set forth in paragraph 1 above, can take appropriate action under Article IV, Section 31 of the Washington State Constitution.




- 1                   3. Judge Bordlemay is presently on administrative  
2                   leave and is not performing any judicial functions.  
3                   Judge Bordlemay agrees that her execution of this  
4                   Stipulation constitutes her resignation from  
5                   office, effective as of January 1, 1996, as set  
6                   forth in the resignation letter attached hereto.  
7                   4. Judge Bordlemay agrees that following the execution  
8                   of this Stipulation, she shall not serve in any  
9                   judicial position that is subject to the Code of  
10                  Judicial Conduct without first securing approval  
11                  from the Commission in the manner provided in WAC  
12                  292-12-160.  
13                  5. The Commission shall close this matter without  
14                  further proceedings, effective on January 1, 1996.  
15                  6. This Stipulation shall not become effective until  
16                  approved by the Commission on Judicial Conduct. If  
17                  the Stipulation is not accepted, the matter will  
18                  proceed as though this Stipulation was not entered  
19                  into.


