2 5. Respondent was reinstated to the active practice of law effective
3 June 24, 1997.

4 6. Respondent did not respond to the Commission's Statement of
5 Allegations served upon him on March 6, 1998. Respondent did not answer the
6 Commission's Statement of Charges served upon him on April 4, 1998.

7 7. On June 3, 1998, Respondent stated to Commission Counsel that
8 he first became aware of the Supreme Court's order of suspension on June 23,
9 1997 after which he immediately paid the funds to reinstate his license.
10 Respondent stated he did not respond to Commission communications earlier
11 because of his apprehension.

14 AGREEMENT

15 1. Based on the foregoing stipulated facts, Respondent agrees that while
16 serving in his capacity as Judge Pro Tempore of the Pierce County District Court
17 No. One in Tacoma, Washington on June 6, 11, 13, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 23,
18 1997, while he was suspended from the practice of law, he did violate Canons 1,
19 2(A), and 3(A)(1) of the Code of Judicial Conduct.

20 2. Respondent agrees that his conduct described in the preceding
21 paragraph warrants the discipline of ADMONISHMENT.


23 3. Respondent further agrees that he shall not seek or hold any judicial


