The above order number refers to Heather K. Van Nuys, Judge of Yakima County Superior Court.

Judge Van Nuys was my client from <u>May 14, 2002</u> to <u>September 3, 2002</u> <u>inclusive</u>. She was referred to me because of her personal death loss experiences; her subsequent level of depression and grief that had been interfering with her work at that time.

I have read the Stipulation, Agreement and Agreed Order of Admonishment in regards to this case.

It is my opinion that when she left treatment with me she was able to handle her job requirements and at that time I had confidence that she was able to manage her workload of cases. At that time I was confident that her decision-making process and abilities would not be in jeopardy, causing undue delays in deciding cases brought before her. I can only speak for Judge Heather K. Van Nuys's level of functioning up to September 3, 2002, but I have little reason to believe that she could not continue to handle her workload appropriately after that date.
