Re: John Wulle (DOB 10-20-50)

Mr. John Wulle sat for an alcohol and other drug assessment at ChangePoint on 1-8-08. We met again on 5-23-08 to talk about questions I had regarding the case and to finalize my recommendations. The results of this assessment are based on information obtained from an in-depth structured interview with the client, a review of the client's personal history form which Mr. Wulle filled out prior to the interview and the client's self reported medical history. I was also given access to declarations of witnesses and I interviewed some of these same witnesses over the phone to get additional information.

This case is one where there is no hard evidence of drinking such as a blood alcohol level or the report of an arresting officer. As a result I am unable to give a diagnosis of abuse or dependence for Mr. Wulle.

<u>Recommendations</u>: that Mr. Wulle attend 12 sessions of outpatient therapy/education on the disease concept, relapse prevention and other topics related to substance abuse. I have given Mr. Wulle the names of two therapists in our area who would be appropriate to provide these sessions for him.
