

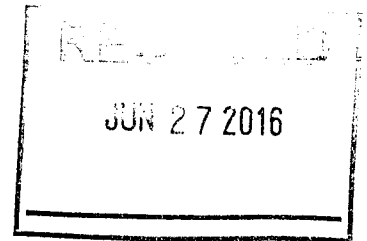

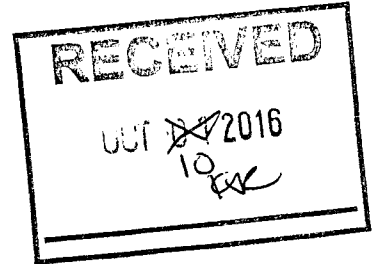

Commissioner Bonnie Canada-Thurston has satisfactorily completed a course of coaching/counseling and behavior modification to address the concerns described in the Stipulation, Agreement and Order of Reprimand, CJC No. 7707-F-167. Her participation in our meetings has accomplished positive changes. In my opinion, she has the competency to maintain these changes in the future.

My opinion is based on Bonnie's active engagement during our meetings. She was well-motivated. She practiced new strategies between our meetings. She displayed positive insights and reported new, behavioral applications.

In addition to my personal observations, I reviewed video recordings of her conduct during hearings over which she presided on August 18, 2016, and August 23, 2016. I received those videos from Attorney Sheryl Willert along with a letter from Family Court Director, Jorene Reiber, indicating that these hearing were randomly selected from Bonnie's morning calendar.

Bonnie's demeanor, tone and conduct were a marked improvement over the pre-coaching videos that I had previously reviewed. In the most recent videos, she behaved in a more patient, courteous, respectful, dignified and businesslike manner. She has acquired the skills to continue this positive conduct as she performs her judicial duties.

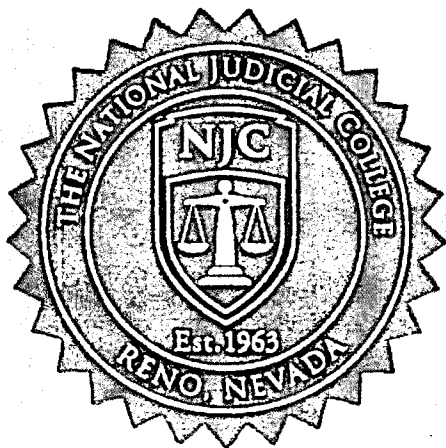


