Presiding Officer Michael Evans and hearing panel members conducted a status conference on Tuesday, May 30, 2023. Participating were Josephine Townsend, counsel for Respondent Judge Darvin Zimmerman, and Paul Taylor, Disciplinary Counsel. Hearing panelists Ramon Alvarez, Terrie Ashby-Scott, Wanda Briggs, and Lin-Marie Nacht attended.

The parties agreed that they have been unable to reach a stipulated resolution in this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


An independent medical records evaluation by a medical expert approved by the Presiding Officer is required to assess Respondent’s ability to participate in a fact-finding hearing.

Ms. Townsend shall provide the names and addresses of all the medical providers who provided the basis for Respondent’s two motions to continue and his current description of his medical condition to Commission Clerk Aimee Baldoz by Friday, June 2, 2023. All of Respondent’s medical records considered in conjunction with this case shall be filed under seal.

The parties may propose an independent physician in the Clark County region to review the medical records and issue a report on Respondent’s fitness to participate, to be approved by the Presiding Officer. The parties were advised that, in addition, a physical medical examination of Respondent may be ordered, if necessary, to clarify Respondent’s future ability to participate in a contested fact-finding hearing.
